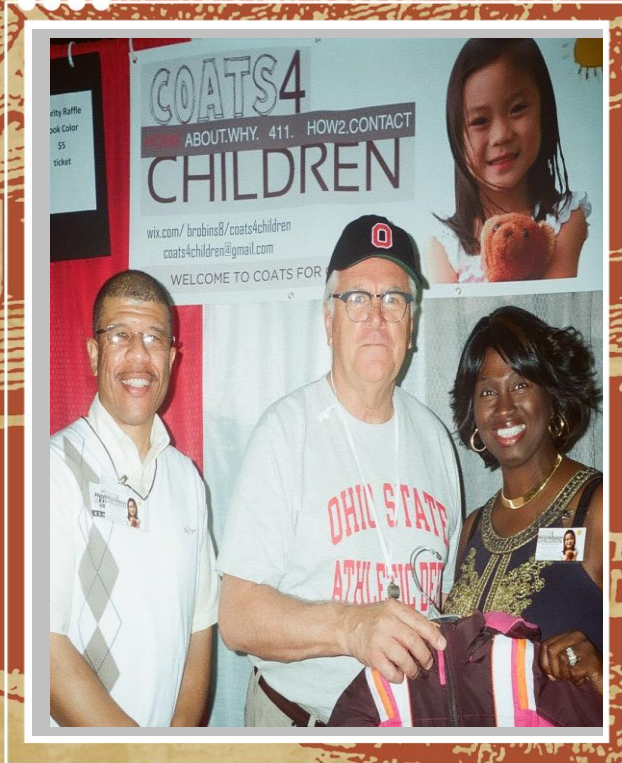

Schools, Places of Worship, Organizations

We donate the coats to schools, organizations, and any place of worship. These groups of community have solid established relationships with the child and their family. This is how we are able to identify the needs on a community level. The school, organization, and place of worship is required to provide **Coats 4 Children** with a letter acknowledging the coat total and sizes given to them for community distribution.

Our mission is to provide **brand new coats** to every child in the state of Ohio in need of warmth. We are not just providing a coat rather self esteem and confidence that the child is worthy of a coat that protects them from the cold Ohio elements. A coat that fits them perfectly and they were the first to own it. This coat signals to the child that corporately and collectively society is with you, and your family's existence matters to us all.

There is a new working class who are challenged in our state they do not qualify for assistance.

Coats 4 Children's mission is to be there for that family rather it is two parents, one parent, grandparent; or a guardian family unit.

Become a Satellite Location

From time to time we receive request from individuals seeking new coats for their children. **Coats 4 Children** would like to deliver the coats to your place of worship, organization and your team can deliver the coats one or two ways to the family in need. 1.) The family can pick the coats up at a scheduled time from your office location. 2.) Your team can deliver the coats to the family.

We would contact your office by phone so **Coats 4 Children** can deliver the coats to your location. We will give you the contact information on the family. Your office will set up the appointment time with the family for them to receive the coat or coats. The family head will need to sign for the receipt of the coats. This receipt is for your office record only. **Coats 4 Children** will just need an electronic email/letter that the coats have been delivered by your organization, place of worship.

This is how your organization, place of worship can become a vital part in the follow-up support that many of these families need. Some may be in need of Pastoral or Organizational Care. At **Coats 4 Children** it is not just a coat but a partnership that society hears the voiceless child and will respond appropriately because that family matters to Ohioans. We not only rally around sports we rally around our children.

Pastor Steve Biffle/ Church of the Living Word is a Satellite Location

Pastor Biffle himself has serviced 24 Cols, Oh families with 49 brand new coats from **Coats 4 Children** in the month of September alone. C4C Executive Director Beverly Robinson says it is important for our children to see ordinary people doing extraordinary things. Ohio's Heroes are showing up for the children's sake.

Host a Coat Party: Call and book your date for the party. Create your guest list of 10 to 20 people. Turn your guest list in within 48 hours of dating your party. The guest list should have names and addresses so invitations can be mailed. The Host will follow-up with a phone call 48hrs before the party. Simple refreshments only need be provided by the Host.

At the party the representative will briefly share with you the purpose of the fundraiser, show pictures and project results. This takes about 20 minutes and 10 minutes for questions and answers about the project. The group will have an opportunity to present their donation individually or collectively.
